Associate in Science to Bachelors of Social Work

Overview

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy the requirements for Associates of Science at the Kentucky Community and Technical College System and leads to a Bachelor's Degree at Brescia University.

University Admission Requirements

Official transcript from all schools attended. Combined grade point of average of a 2.0 or higher.

School of Social Work Admission Requirements

Students must complete these courses before formally applying to the school of social work: Intro to Social Work, Intro to Sociology, Intro to Psychology, and Human Biology. Student must also have SW 301 in progress. After completing the prerequisites, students make a formal application to the program. Students will be enrolled in a BSW Application Moodle page, where they will submit the application material. The application material must include the following items

1. An [application form](#).
2. A copy of a photo identification card**.
3. A 5-10 minute autobiographical video. ([See Instructions](#))
4. A written response, not to exceed 5 pages, including an introduction of self, addressing appreciation for diversity, macro social work, and awareness of social work ethics. ([See Instructions](#))
5. A recommendation form from a social work instructor who has taught the student ([See Form](#))
6. A GPA of 2.5 or higher.
