



## TRANSFER PATHWAY GUIDE

Associate in Science to Bachelors of Social Work

### **Overview**

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy the requirements for Associates of Science at the Kentucky Community and Technical College System and leads to a Bachelor's Degree at Brescia University.

### **University Admission Requirements**

Official transcripts from all schools attended. Combined grade point of average of a 2.0 or higher.

### **School of Social Work Admission Requirements**

Students must complete these courses before formally applying to the school of social work: Intro to Social Work, Intro to Sociology, Intro to Psychology, and Human Biology. Students must also have SW 301 in progress. After completing the prerequisites, students make a formal application to the program. Students will be enrolled in a BSW Application Moodle page, where they will submit the application material. The application material must include the following items:

1. An [application form](#).
2. A copy of a photo identification card\*\*.
3. A 5–10-minute autobiographical video. ([See Instructions](#))
4. A written response, not to exceed 5 pages, including an introduction of self, addressing appreciation for diversity, macro social work, and awareness of social work ethics. ([See Instructions](#))
5. A recommendation form from a social work instructor who has taught the student ([See Form](#))
6. A GPA of 2.5 or higher.
