- The qualified candidate will have earned a Ph.D. in Philosophy (preferred); Masters degree is required. Tenure-track option only available to candidates with a terminal degree;
- Preference will be given to candidates with teaching experience – including online teaching, and with training in contemporary pedagogy;
- The University seeks candidates who have a passion for their discipline and who can successfully invite students to engage in that same love of philosophy and “the big questions”;
- Demonstrated commitment to community engagement, academic advising, and collegial service.

Responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- Teaching introduction and upper-division philosophy courses on-ground;
- Teaching introduction and upper-division philosophy courses online;
- Teaching courses for the university’s diaconate program and Honors College;
- Overseeing student advising in the Philosophy minor;
