CAMPUS Rx: Brescia University collaborates with Campus RX to offer students an opportunity to have discounted subscription for unlimited access to medical and behavioral health services from the convenience of their phone, smartphone, or computer. For \$8 per month, registered members can consult with a doctor to discuss symptoms related to illness or reach a counselor for behavioral health. Members can speak with a doctor or counselor via telephone or video chat 24 hours per day, 7 days per week, 365 days per year, anywhere in USA. Unlimited visits. Campus Rx serves as an alternative to urgent care clinics and expensive ER visits for non-emergency conditions.

Campus Rx was created as a way to provide access to the convenience of telehealth services. Convenient medical/mental health care is as easy as this 1.2.3 process:

- Connect: Download the Campus RX app from the Google Play Store or App Store or register online at www.campusrxnow.com. (Must use firstname.lastname@brescia.edu email address; promo code: BEARCATS.) *After membership established, up to 7 immediate family members in USA can be added at no additional charge!
- 2. Triage: Complete a brief medical history and include a list of medications and current symptoms.
- 3. Consult: Members can connect with a board certified doctor or master counselor licensed in their state via telephone or video visit. After a diagnosis is made by physician, any necessary prescriptions are sent to a pharmacy of your choice.

By using the promo code: BEARCATS students can subscribe for unlimited access to medical and behavioral health for \$8 per month. This reflects a \$16.95/month discount on regular Campus Rx membership. A one-time enrollment fee of \$9.95 is added to first month only. There are no additional co-pays. Your insurance is not billed. You are responsible for costs of prescribed medication. Campus Rx physicians and master counselors cannot practice outside of the USA, however can assist students currently residing in USA.
